

Please keep your meter pit clear of all snow and debris, do not remove the (blue) flag, until after the last snow of the season.

Located in your front or side yard

Sidewalks –

Snow and Ice must be cleared within 24 hours, after the snow stops falling.

Underground Sprinkler Systems –

Avoid costly repairs have your backflow preventer and sprinkler lines, blown out before the first freeze.
